

Parker's Company of Minute Men. Josiah was with the Company June 17 and 18, 1775 on the Bunker Hill alarm. Timothy married Millicent Perry and had 1 or 13 children. The family removed from Lexington to Wendell, and then to Deerfield. He died January 13, 1831 in Deerfield, Massachusetts. Photos of the gravestones in Old Deerfield Cemetery of Timothy and Millicent have been obtained for this genealogy.

**Notes for MILLICENT PERRY:**

Milicent's parents removed from Noodle's Island in Boston Harbor about 1760 to Lexington, Massachusetts. Millicent married Timothy Blodgett and they had 12 children according to one source and 13 by a second one. The second source notes her birth date as 05 March 1746., and her death date as the 06 May 1827. More research will have to be done to varify which dates are correct.

JOSIAH<sup>8</sup> BLODGETT** (*SAMUEL<sup>7</sup>, THOMAS<sup>6</sup>, SAMUEL<sup>5</sup>, THOMAS<sup>4</sup>, ROBERT<sup>3</sup>, ROBERT<sup>2</sup>, THOMAS<sup>1</sup> BLOWGATE*) was born 28-December-1737 in Lexington, Massachusetts. He married JANE THORN 24-April-1760 in Lexington, Massachusetts.

**Notes for JOSIAH BLODGETT:**

Josiah Blodgett, the 6th child of Samuel Blodgett and Mary Russell, was born 28 December 1737 in Lexington. He was a soldier in the French War and repaired to Cambridge under Capt. John Parker, 17 and 18 June 1775 on the Bunker Hill Alarm. He married Jane Thorn of Lexington 24 April, 1760. Their two sons, Azubah and Soloman/Salmon were born in Lexington. Josiah, Jane and two children named Salmon (?) and Azubah, from Lexington, were at Elkanah Welch's house in Woburn precinct, 16 Feb. 1771. -- Town Rec. 9: 114. He was taxed Woburn Second Precinct, 1777-1783. Compare State List, 2: 199, for military service.
