Soloman, the second child and son of Josiah Blodgett and Jane Thorn, was born 21 April 1766 in Lexington, Massachusetts. He enlisted from Woburn, aged 16, stature 5 ft. 3 in., light complexion, light hair, blue eyes, occupation laborer, for three years, 01 April 1781. See State List, 2:197.

Issac was a member of Capt. John Parker's Company of Minute Men and was with his brother at the Battle of Lexington on April 19, 1775.

Timothy and Elizabeth came from Northfield, Massachusetts, in the spring of 1797, and settled first on L 4 R 8, which was previously owned by Thomas Stratton. It is believed that Parna, Ashley and Betsy were born in Wendell, Massachusetts, Joseph was born in Northfield, Massachusetts and Malta, Roxana, Timothy, Nancy and Louisa were born in Fitzwilliam.
